**Community Advocacy, Information, and Referral (CAIR) Program**

CAIR provides information, referrals, practical resources and access to various community agencies.

**Counseling Services**

Substance Abuse and Mental Health Clinic services for youth, adults and families.  
Sessions will satisfy court mandated counseling.

**Crisis Intervention**

Short term crisis and supportive counseling for members of surrounding community.

**Children's Emotional Wellness Screenings**

Emotional wellness screenings for youngsters, ages 3 to 18.

**SeniorNet**

Helping seniors, 50 years+, on basic computer use, program application and social media.

**RECESS**

Provides therapeutic recreation to children ages 7-14 with emotional problems. Through group intervention, educational technique and skill building, this program is geared to helping children improve their day-to-day functionality including age-appropriate impulse control and improving socialization skills.
