



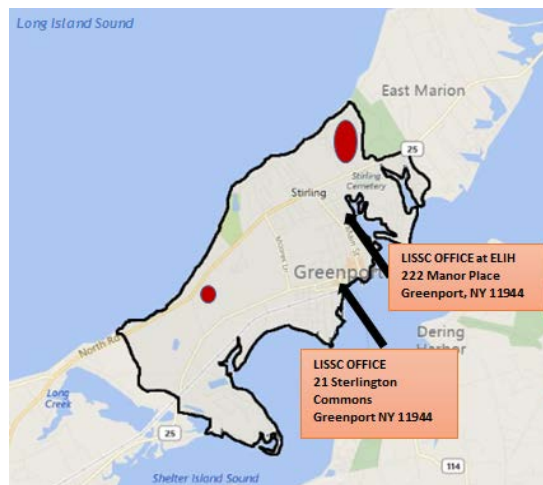
# Long Island Sound Senior Care
