FSL is having a big impact on the lives of our clients during this health crisis.

Everyday FSL's professionally trained staff offer over sixty programs which help children, families, and seniors who are struggling. Services include counseling, advocacy, treatment, and referrals to critical resources. FSL programs are often a life-line for those looking to begin their journey to a better tomorrow.



Alternatives For Youth (AFY) is a program designed for adolescences, and their families, who are at risk of entering the juvenile justice system. The program features counseling, visits to the home, and offers various support services.

On March 30th, Joey, a 16-year-old participant of AFY, contacted his FSL case worker to share his concerns about his father being diagnosed with COVID-19 and family being in quarantine together. His home life had been strained for a few years, but now his parents and siblings were arguing constantly. He shared his emotional challenges which included a real sense of fear that his family would become ill and concern that there would be very limited money coming into his household. Joey's case worker was able to arrange on-line counseling where they discussed focusing on his strengths, developing coping skills, and concentrating on schoolwork so he didn't fall behind again. Joey decided this was the time to make some positive changes and acknowledged that the group of friends he had been hanging out with were not helping him with his dream of graduating and going to college. Being in quarantine gave him the unexpected opportunity to distance himself from those who did not share the goals he had set for himself. The case worker contacted Joey's mother to arrange for her to come to the food pantry and provided an outlet for the other family members to receive counseling support. Over the past eight weeks, Joey and his family have begun to develop a new routine which includes better communication skills and acknowledging the importance of supporting each other. Thankfully, his father has recuperated and is working again. Plans have been made for Joey to the continue with the counseling sessions and he is on track to graduate from high school next June.

Healthy Families Suffolk is a home-visiting program offering services to expectant families and new parents with infants under the age of three months. This vital resource is based in the Brentwood, Bay Shore, Central Islip, Copiague, Amityville, and Wyandanch communities. Client may receive long-term, in-home services until their child is pre-school age or kindergarten ready. The program helps those who are vulnerable by enhancing family functioning through education, improving support systems, teaching problem-solving skills, building positive parent-child interaction, and promoting healthy child development.

Annie, a 21-year-old woman, has been dealing with sporadic incidents of domestic violence from her partner for the past two years. She came to FSL when she was pregnant with a goal of breaking the cycle of violence that she found herself in. Annie admitted that this was a very similar environment to which she and her siblings were raised and became accustomed to after years of abuse. She loved her partner, but realized that his outburst had become more frequent and unpredictable. She attributed this to the stress of being together all

the time due to the quarantine of Covid-19, and the loss of his second job combined with his increased drinking. Something had to change, his erratic behavior made her fear for the safety of her child. During a recent counseling session Annie suggested that she wanted the FSL social worker to call Child Protective Services and asked that her abuser be removed from their home. Although, the situation was a much safer environment for both the young mother and her 10-month-old baby, this presented a pressing financial burden. FSL staff was able to provide Annie with an appointment for the food pantry, referrals for Domestic Violence counseling, assisted her in signing up for SNAP benefits, and provided essential items for them to begin their new life.

These are just two of the thousands of people we are able to help thanks to the support of generous individuals and corporations who believe in the important mission of Restoring Hope and Rebuilding Lives. FSL's clients and their families have expressed endless gratitude to have someone to talk with and programs to rely on as they overcome the emotional and financial difficulties in their lives.
