SUMMER CAMP

This has been a challenging summer for all - especially children living in poverty. For many years, and with the help of generous donors, FSL has worked with families to give hundreds of children the experience of attending summer camp. This year we created a new model of "camp" and gave families options that would best suit their child's individual situation. With the funds available through the FSL Camper Scholarship Program our team was able to coordinate a variety of experiences. These included field trip adventures like hiking, beach outings, the LI Adventure Park for ziplining with a ropes course, fishing, and "Chef for a Day" experiences, and structured virtual camps.

In addition, the FSL Scholarship funds allowed for us to distribute "Camp in A Bag" activity kits for children. Kits included crafts, educational games, STEM activities, and assorted toys, and a Fire tablet. The FSL Shelter team purchased materials, games and activities for staff led programs throughout the summer months.

FSL's CAMP Champions are the major underwriters of the Scholarship Program. Their 3 year commitment of \$2,500 per year gives this program a strong dependable foundation. Our thanks to the 2020 Champions!
