Suffolk County Executive Steve Bellone and Long Island's Non-Profit Organizations are urging Federal Officials to Provide Emergency Assistance to Prevent Defunding of Healthcare, Addiction, Domestic Violence, Senior and Youth Services across Suffolk County

Suffolk County Executive Steve Bellone met with Karen Boorshtein, FSL's President & CEO, and other Executive Directors of Long Islands leading non-profit organization last week at FSL's DASH Center for a Press Conference calling on the federal government to deliver federal disaster assistance. The COVID-19 pandemic has caused unprecedented loss of revenues and increased costs for counties, local municipalities and non-profit organizations. County Executive Bellone stated that the County will have no choice but to make catastrophic budget cuts to contract agencies that receive County funding without significant federal disaster assistance. The County Executive made a direct appeal to President Trump, requesting that he call upon U.S. Senate Majority Leader Mitch McConnell to pass a federal disaster assistance bill in the U.S. Senate to prevent these potential devastating cuts.
