# **Remembering Kristy Irvine Ryan**

Sometimes a grieving family will continue the good work of loved one as part of their legacy. This was the inspiration for Kristy's Smile Inc., a non-profit 501(c)3 organization. The foundation was motivated by the amazing spirit and compassion of the late Kristy Ryan who tragically died in the World Trade Center on September 11th. Kristy and her friends had been longtime donors to FSL and often given surprise gifts and new bedding to children and families struggling financially. Kristy's kindness and willingness to always think of those less fortunate had encouraged her friends and family to continue this good work in her memory. Since 2007, Kristy's Smile has provided over \$300,000 in funding to FSL by hosting annual golf outings and fundraisers. In recent years, the foundation provided over \$30,000 for the Huntington Interfaith Homeless Initiative (HIHI). HIHI offers homeless individuals in Huntington a safe, warm place to spend the night during the winter months. Comprised of more than 35 local congregations, the groups provides housing, clothing, a hot dinner, breakfast, and bag lunch to participants. Another generous gesture was the purchase of two vans which provide needed transportation to day programs specifically designed to assist adults suffering from chronic mental illness.
