FSL's East End Certified Community Behavioral Health Clinic (CCBHC) offers 24-hour care for those who are struggling with mental health issues and/or substance use disorders. This convenient community-based outpatient program was created for children and adults residing in Suffolk County. CCBHC services are available to everyone - those insured and uninsured. FSL wants to help people begin their journey to a healthier life!

FSL's East End Outpatient CCBHC offers:

- A dedicated professional team which includes nurse practitioners in psychiatry, registered nurses, social workers, credentialed alcoholism and substance abuse counselors, case managers and peer specialists – all offering support and guidance.
- Medical screenings, assessments and diagnosis, crisis care, counseling, medication management, psychiatric evaluation, and rehabilitation services.
- Individual, group, or family therapy, and same-day access to care and referrals to other resources.
- Targeted treatment plans offered in a caring and comfortable environment that is designed to help individuals improve their quality of life and for their families to feel supported throughout the treatment and recovery process.
- Whole-person, integrated care includes on-site primary medical services, monitoring, and treatment of medical conditions such as heart disease, diabetes, or COPD.
- Mobile Crisis Team (MCT) delivers crisis care to schools, businesses, homes, and other locations throughout the community.
- Care designed for the unique issues faced by members of the armed forces and veterans.
- Specialized 24-hour services available to stabilize people experiencing crisis.
