Community leaders, supporters, and staff gathered for the Ribbon-Cutting of the Huntington Family Center (HFC) located at 1264 New York Avenue, Huntington Station. This new and expanded site, formerly at Manor Field, is a critical resource for over 3,500 children and adults residing in Greater Huntington.

The programs offered at this unique multi-service facility include Advocacy, Information and Referral, crisis counseling, housing, youth services, job training, and employment services. HFC also houses representatives from the Suffolk County Department of Labor, the Suffolk County Department of Social Services, PSEG, Western Suffolk BOCES English as a Second Language program, and the Health & Welfare Council of Long Island. Additionally, the Lockwood Early Learning Center provides early education classes for preschoolers.
