FSL recently hosted a press conference with Senator [Monica R. Martinez](#) and AARP NY State Director Beth Finkel at our Iovino South Shore Center in Bay Shore. AARP is lobbying NYS for \$51 million to help eliminate the waiting list for services like transportation, housekeeping, and personal care for older New Yorkers. They are also calling for more transparency about where the waiting list exists by county, and directing financial assistance to unpaid family caregivers.
