Founded in Huntington in 1926 as a social service agency, FSL has grown substantially. Today, we have 60+ social service and counseling programs in more than 20 locations, and a dedicated staff of over 700 to serve Long Island's most vulnerable citizens. From seniors seeking companionship to those seeking shelter, to those suffering from addiction and mental illness, and to families lacking essentials -FSL offers support and security when people need it most!



The PSEG Foundation's grant in support of the Advancing Equity in Human Services program is helping FSL continue to lead the way in creating inclusive environments and systems, ensuring that every

client experiences fair access to optimal care. The lunch and learn model provides invaluable feedback from clients and helps ensure we are in touch with the changing needs of our community. FSL continuously strives to exceed industry standards and best practices for delivering top-quality care to Long Islanders, and we remain dedicated to making a positive impact in the lives of those we serve.



Paddlers for Humanity granted a generous \$10,000 award in support of our East Hampton Clinic. This office provides care for a diverse population regardless of one's ability to pay, and currently serves 402 clients, 90 of them children and adolescents. The clinic provides both group therapy and individual counseling in the areas of Psychiatric Evaluations, Psychotherapy, Medication Management, Crisis Intervention, and Care Coordination.

For the past 10 years, Paddlers for Humanity has generously supported FSL's Community Behavioral Health Collaborative which provided mental health and suicide prevention services in East End schools. This funding enables us to provide services tailored to meet the unique needs of those living on the East End.



The compassion and empathy of people like Meg Gary and Board member Slava Vero help make a difference in the lives of our neighbors in need. Thanks to the dedication and support of all of our volunteers and donors, FSL is able to provide life's safety-net services and basic necessities to thousands of children, teens, and adults. Our clinical team includes social workers, peers, and case managers all working together to enhance access to care. Our team works with substance abuse prevention, harm reduction, treatment, and recovery providers throughout Suffolk County to coordinate, individualized comprehensive care.

FSL IS MAKING AN IMPACT IN OUR COMMUNITY!



FSL offers 5 unique programs designed to help LI's seniors live their best lives. Services range from advocating and providing critical support, to respite for the caregivers who love them.

Every year, 5,000+ children are given new backpacks full of school supplies to start the school year. This year, 244 children and adolescents with serious emotional disturbances or medical conditions are participating in our Health Home Care Management Services.

Through our referral pathways with local hospitals, over 2,000 people were connected to FSL for ongoing clinical services. Over 24,000 children and adults struggling with severe mental health or addiction issues have been assessed, treated, and provided with counseling and support at DASH. (March 2019 - Dec. 2024)

Over 93,414 calls have been received at our DASH crisis care center in the past 6 years! Project TOY, FSL's annual gift drive, provided more than 6,600 children with a brighter holiday. Our thanks to lead sponsor FourLeaf and hundreds of other generous donors.

600 children and adults are living in our Network of Shelters which consists of 7 facilities across LI. Residents are provided with safe housing, food, counseling, and vital care.

In 2024, 315 individuals and families were moved from our network of shelters into permanent housing!

Playing, learning, and growing in a safe and nurturing environment can change a child's life. This can only happen with the compassion and vision of our Camp Champions and other generous donors.
